Cold Weather Equipment Sled Background

- **Requirement Document**
 - Being developed (CD&I)
- **Mobile sled required for movement of crew served weapons, ammo, etc.**
 - New item to inventory
 - Lightweight and durable, transport approx 200 lbs of gear over snow / ice covered terrain
 - Used by one to three Marines (main pull by front poles, assist pull with side harnesses)
 - Utilize duffel bag inside sled space for waterproofing gear (space = 1800 cubic inches)
 - Length approx 60 inches, width approx 22 inches
 - Demonstrate maneuverability and flotation under load
 - Also used for casualty evacuation
