

Seabees – Can Do


- Established May 18th, 1942 as Advanced Base Depot, Port Hueneme to support the newly created Construction Battalions
- Primary mission is to train, equip, supply, and mobilize Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps Officers; and to sustain them while deployed
- Involved in all US military operations since WWII: Korea, Vietnam, Iraq, Somalia, Bosnia, Kosovo, Afghanistan (OEF), and Iraq(OIF)






