


Defense Standardization Program



- Cataloging and Standardization Act, Public Law 82-436 as codified by United States Code, Title 10, Chapter 145, Sections 2451 & 2452
- DoD Instruction 4120.24, Defense Standardization Program
 - Implements Public Law 10 USC 2451 and 2452
- USD AT&L provides overall policy direction
 - Defense Standardization Program Office (DSPO)
 - DoD-wide Standardization policy, procedures & guidance
 - Automated Tools
 - Training / Education
 - Over 100 DoD Standardization Activities




Deputy Under Secretary of Defense (Logistics & Materiel Readiness)

Achieve DoD-wide Standardization Goals

- Support interoperability and improve logistics readiness by promoting commonality of systems, components, and architectures
- Provide products and services of value through an integrated standardization process
- Reduce Total Ownership Costs through standardization of interfaces, architectures, processes and parts



Synergistic Relationship



Technical Group

- Responsible for determining functional requirements
- Chartered by a senior sponsor or executive group that fosters joint solutions related to engineering, technical, logistics or sustainment issues
- Operating principles and practices established to support the technical working group and interface with the technical community

Joint Standardization Board

- Responsible for identifying standardization opportunities
- Chartered by the Defense Standardization Executive to foster interoperability and improve logistics readiness by promoting commonality of systems and components
- Operating principles and practices established to bridge the gap between the technical group and the standardization community
